They are the only assistance dog charity to train dogs specially for disabled children. Since 1988 the charity has trained over 350 partnerships.

An assistance dog acts as a great ice-breaker enabling our clients to break out of the isolation often experienced through disability. Every dog is trained to help with simple everyday tasks such as opening doors, picking up the morning post, emptying the washing machine, even retrieving dropped items such as a TV remote, keys or a wallet.
