THE CINEMA EXHIBITORS' ASSOCIATION CARD (CEA CARD)

This is a national card that can be used to verify that the holder is entitled to one free ticket for a person accompanying them to the cinema.

To apply for the card, you will need to meet one or more of the following criteria:

1. Be in receipt of the Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Attendance Allowance (AA).
2. Be a registered blind person.

The card is valid for 1 year from the date of issue. Application forms are available from cinemas across the UK supporting this card. Alternatively, you can download an application form.

A processing fee of **£5.50** is chargeable per card. This is to be sent along with the completed application.
